Choose songs suitable for students' age and level, and guide students to conduct complete singing training by learning the lyrics, tunes, rhythms and emotions of songs.

Pay attention to students' individual differences, and provide individual counseling and guidance according to students' characteristics and level to help them overcome difficulties and improve their singing level.

Not any song or any method is suitable for use. When using it, it must be combined with the content of the song. 


Figure 1: Diagram Show the Ancient Chinese Art Song Workbook for High School Vocal Students.
